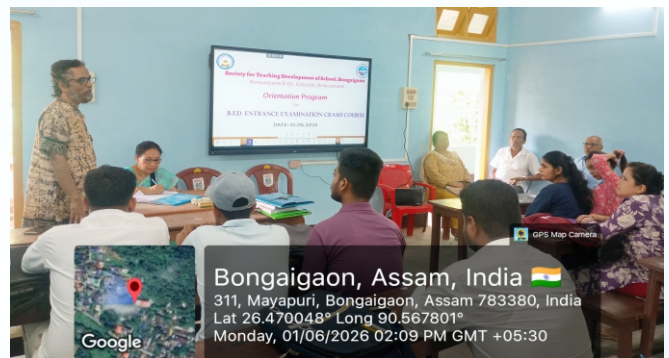

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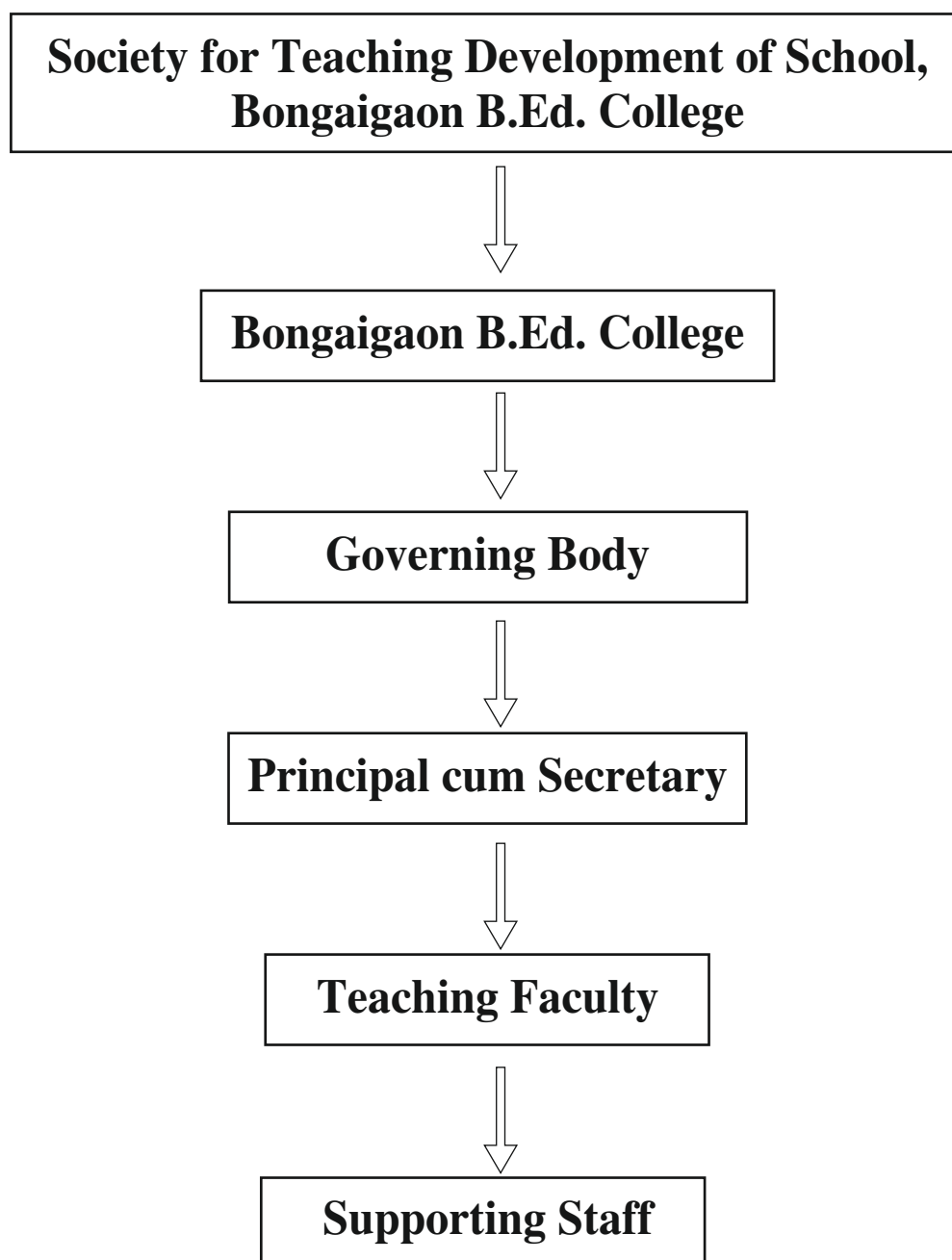

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THE GENESIS OF BONGAIGAON B.ED. COLLEGE.....

In the second half of the 20th century, the idea of establishing a quality teacher training institute occupied the minds of several socially conscious citizens of the Greater Bongaigaon area. The education enthusiasts decided to make an organized attempt with optimistic note. The other lifelong educators of Greater Bongaigaon of that time extended their full cooperation. Thus the first Executive committee was constituted on 17th December 1989 at a public meeting held at Birjhora Higher Secondary School under the Presidentship of Mr. Binanda Chandra Pathak, Rtd. Principal, Birjhora H.S. School. Mr. Phani Bhushan Choudhury, Former M.L.A and Mr. Lakshmi Kanta Ray, the then Assistant Teacher of Birjhora H.S. School were selected as President & Secretary of Executive Committee to realize the long-cherished vision of establishing a teacher training institute in lower Assam area. Consequently, a new teacher training institute named Bongaigaon B.Ed. College was established at Bongaigaon on 31st August 1990.

The Executive Committee members and well wishers rendered their selfless service carrying out all the necessary arrangements in building the institute with their organized efforts and dedicated leadership. The Executive Committee with support from the Principal, Teachers and Employees of the college looked after all necessary works related to running of B.Ed. College till 2008.

Subsequently, as per directives of NCTE, the Society for Teaching Development of Schools, (STDS) Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, Bongaigaon, was formed in the year 2003 with Phani Bhushan Choudhury, former MLA Bongaigaon as the president and Shri Lakshmi Kanta Ray, Rtd. Principal Birjhora H.S. School as founder Secretary of STDS which was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860. Later in 2008, as per directives from Gauhati University, the first Governing Body of B.Ed. College was formed with Shri Phani Bhusan Choudhury as the President of Governing Body.

Bongaigaon B.Ed. College is running with Non-profit motive under the sponsorship of the said society and academic, administrative rules and guidance of Gauhati University till date. The college has been maintaining an excellent academic record consistently since establishment. Furthermore, B.A. (FYUGP) Arts programme has been running successfully in this college since 2022.

Location:

The College is situated in Bongaigaon, 1.5 km from Bongaigaon town in the District of Bongaigaon, Near Maa Bagheswari Temple, Assam. According to GIS it is located at 26.40144 latitudinal and 90.567984 longitudinal positions. It is surrounded by eye- soothing landscape of nature. Beautiful Birjhora Tea Garden are in the East and North direction.

Rules of Admission as per Gauhati University, Guwahati

1. After the publication of Gauhati University Final Merit list our college will issue admission form to publish the College Merit list. (Any graduate with minimum 50% marks in case of unreserved candidate and 45% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidate are eligible to apply).
2. The College will published admission list according to Merit and Category wise.
3. Selected candidates will have to take their admission on the given dates otherwise their candidature will be automatically cancelled.
4. The candidate should produce all the related original documents at the time of admission.
5. Any Candidate found producing false information, his/her candidature will be cancelled
6. Selected Candidates working in any department have to produce NOC from Competent authority at the time of admission.
7. Selected Candidates having any gap period have to produce original gap certificate at the time of admission.
8. A minimum of 80% Biometric Attendance is mandatory; otherwise the trainees will not be allowed to sit in the final examination.
9. Incomplete forms will be rejected.

N.B.:

- Admission list is prepared considering the category which is mentioned in the final merit list published by Gauhati University.
- Admission & Student Union Fees Rs. **88,000.00** (Eighty Eight Thousand only).
- Admission fee should be made in One-time payment by Challan in favour of Bongaigaon B.Ed. College (Apex Bank A/C No. **581042010002401**) or Online.
- The candidate should bring the formula for converting CGPA into percentage along with them.
- If any candidates want to withdraw seat in given time notified in admission list.
- If any candidate withdrawn his/her seat, 10% of the total fees will be deducted.
- Amount of fees will not be refunded; if any candidate wants to cancel his/her seat after submitting the list to Gauhati University.
